How Does the Non-Invasive Urbanek TMJ Device Work?

1. Takes 90% of Pressure off the TMJ

The Urbanek device is a small acrylic device that is worn on the maxillary (upper arch). It keeps the posterior (back) teeth out of occlusion by 1 to 1.5 mm, resulting in taking 90% of the pressure off the TMJ.

2. Reduces Inflammation

The device is worn 24 hours a day (except for eating) for the first 2 months. After 2 months, it is only worn at night. This allows enough time for the joint to rest and reduce inflammation.
